- If a child wishing to participate is wearing slippers, sandals, a skirt or other clothing that may pose a safety hazard, entry may be restricted.

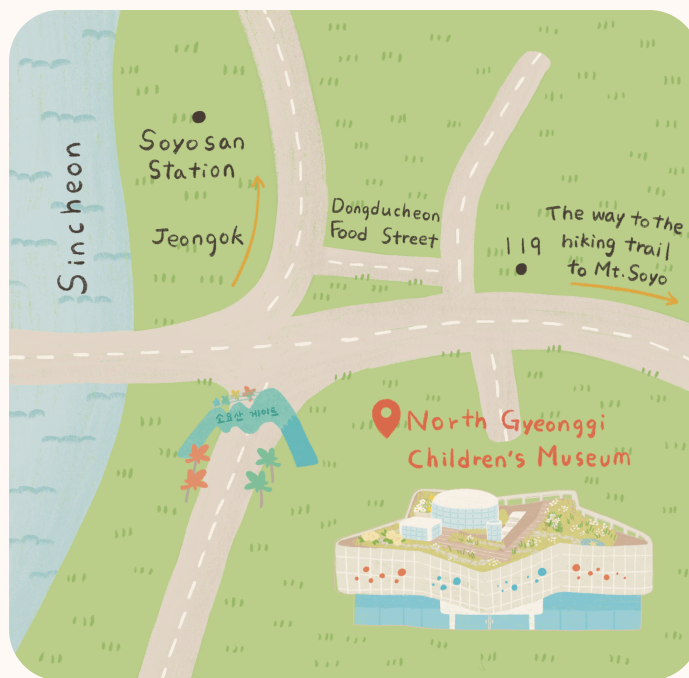
Education Programs

- Bus** Get off at Soyo-san Station bus stop and walk for 5 minutes.
- Subway** Take Exit 1 of Soyo-san Station (Line 1) and walk for 8 minutes.
- Car** Take National Route 3 towards Dongducheon and turn right at Soyo-san Junction. The museum is 300 meters ahead.
